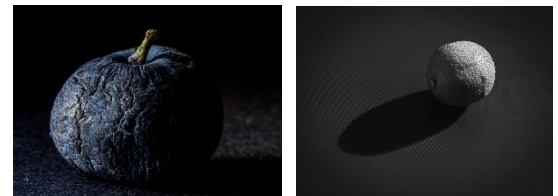
FEBRUARY IN SUMMARY

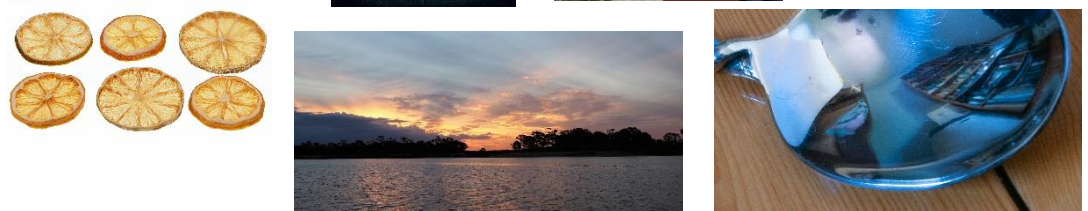
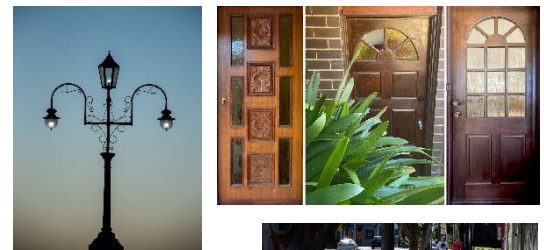
