An arrangement of inanimate objects in an artificial or natural setting, typically commonplace objects which are either natural (food, flowers, dead animals, plants, rocks, shells, etc.) or man-made (drinking glasses, books, vases, jewellery, coins, etc.) The important elements to focus on are the arrangement of the objects, the lighting and the symbolism of the objects.

Note that for the purposes of this competition, "Still Life" excludes the related subject "Table Tops", which mostly includes story telling scenes made up of plastic models or Lego/Duplo constructions
