It is with great pleasure that I announce the results of our entries into this year's VAPS Interclub.

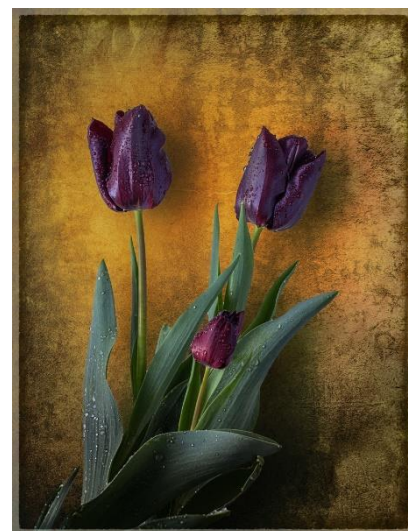
Caulfield Photographic Society came **equal third** with a total of 179 for **Prints**, with Southern Suburbs equaling our score.

Vanitas Still Life is a symbolic work of art showing the transience of life, the futility of pleasure, and the certainty of death, often contrasting symbols of wealth and symbols of ephemerality and death. A common genre in the Low Countries during the 16th and 17th centuries, they have also been created at other times and in other media and styles. Common vanitas symbols include skulls, which are a reminder of the certainty of death; rotten fruit (decay); bubbles (the brevity of life and suddenness of death); smoke, watches, and hourglasses (the brevity of life); and musical instruments (also symbolizing the brevity and ephemeral nature of life). Fruit, flowers and butterflies can be interpreted in the same way, and a peeled lemon was, like life, attractive to look at but bitter to taste.
