

Caulfield Photographic Society – Monthly Comps 2019

Animals – March 4th, 2019 (Entries due February 4th)

Capture a picture of a living animal (including mammals, reptiles, birds, insects and other invertebrates etc, but **excluding humans**). Try to present an image which goes beyond a simple pictorial representation of the animal. Look for humour, emotion or action to lift your image.

Hands – April 1st, 2019 (Entries due March 4th)

Create an image showing human hands (or hand). The hands need not dominate the image, but must be an integral and important part of the picture story.

Bicycles – April 29th, 2019 (Entries due April 1st)

Create an image where a bicycle or bicycles are an important element to the image. The image may include cyclists and other people, or even be a close-up of a bicycle.

Movement - May 27th, 2019 (Entries due April 29th)

Create an image which incorporates or expresses movement. You can use subject movement, camera movement or even implied movement where picture elements suggest directional motion.

Balls – July 1st, 2019 (Entries due May 27th)

Create an image which in which a ball or balls are an important part of the picture story.

Senior portrait (Paul Robinson Trophy) – July 29th, 2019

(Digitals due July 26th, bring prints on the night)

Create a portrait of a person who is at least 65 years old. Do your best to go beyond a simple smiley portrait and seek to express the character of your subject.

Backlit – August 26th, 2019 (Entries due July 29th)

Create an image where the primary light source is coming toward the camera. Ideally you should use the light source to highlight and draw attention to your subject, or use the light to add depth and mood to your image. Silhouettes are acceptable, however some front lighting is fine provided the backlighting dominates.

Umbrellas – September 23rd, 2019 (Entries due August 26th)

Create an image where an umbrella or umbrellas are integral to the image or the story depicted. The umbrellas need not dominate the image, but must be an important part of the picture story.

Mountains (Internal club judging) – Oct 21st, 2019 (Entries due Sept 23rd)

Show us a landscape created in, or of a mountainous region.

Eyes November 11th, 2019 (Entries due October 21st)

Create an image where eyes are the focus of the picture. The eyes need not fill the frame, but must be an attention-grabbing element! The eyes must be human or animal. Potato eyes are not acceptable!
